## PRESENTERS

**PATRICK PALACCI** | **Brånemark Osseointegration Center, Marseille | DDS**

Dr Palacci obtained his DDS degree at Marseille University, Marseille, France, in 1975. He continued his post-graduate education in periodontology at Boston University from 1977 to 1981. He was appointed as a visiting professor in 1982 at Boston University. Dr Palacci is a private practitioner in Marseille and is at the head of Brånemark Osseointegration Center in Marseille, working in very tight relationship with Professor Per-Ingvar Brånemark. He developed several techniques in relation with optimal implant positioning, papilla regeneration technique and esthetic implant dentistry. He is the author of numerous scientific articles and two textbooks published by Quintessence in 1995 and 2001 "Esthetic & Implant Dentistry", as well as another book "Immediate Esthetics" (2008). Dr Palacci got the first NobelPharma Award in 1995. Dr Palacci presently conducts a number of courses in his private clinic and is invited as a speaker to scientific meetings all around the world.

**ULF NANNMARK** | **Göteborg University, Sweden | DDS, PhD**

Dr Nannmark obtained his DDS degree at Göteborg University, Göteborg, Sweden, in 1985. He continued with research under the mentorship of professor Per-Ingvar Brånemark and defended his thesis in 1992. The same year he became Senior lecturer (Docent) at the Göteborg University. Until 2004 he was appointed Associate professor at the Brånemark Osseointegration Center in Göteborg working in close collaboration with P-I Brånemark in developing different methods in OI rehabilitation. Since then he is working in private practice as well as developing methods for bone regeneration. He is the author of more than 100 scientific articles and book chapters. He is both lecturing and giving courses all around the world.



## BRÅNEMARK OSSEOINTEGRATION CENTER | MARSEILLE

The Brånemark Osseointegration Center (BOC) in Göteborg, Sweden, was founded 1989. BOCs primary mission was to provide treatment for patients with severe oral, maxillofacial and orthopedic impediments. A thorough appreciation of tissue handling, biological processes and patient care have developed into fundamental principles, which together with specially designed components and instruments have come to be the basic concept of Osseointegration. Since September 26, 2005 P-I Brånemark Institute, Bauru, Brazil (The Institute) is now the international base into which BOC Göteborg, Sweden has merged and has the same mission as before and is directed by P-I Brånemark and coordinated by Barbro K Brånemark. The rehabilitation of severely compromised patients using osseointegration has been adopted and accepted worldwide. Supported by continued basic and clinical research, a large number of additional indications as well as modifications of clinical procedures has emerged. The expansion of usage has also resulted in numerous additions, changes and sometimes simplifications and improvements of components and instruments used in the various clinical applications of osseointegration.

The ongoing research and development efforts have been greatly enhanced by suggestions, comments and ideas from interested researchers and clinicians worldwide.

This international collaboration, together with participation from several commercial entities, has resulted in an increased body of knowledge.

In an effort to support international collaboration, based on patient care and sound biological and clinical principles, Association of Brånemark Osseointegration Centers (ABOC), was founded some years ago. The formation and development of this unique collaboration has been based on mutual personal and clinical respect, as well as an array of projects and services outlined in formal agreements. Besides the immediate mutual benefits provided through this collaboration, a fundamental principle, that of putting the patient in focus, as well as a common understanding of clinical and biological aspects, have served as a guiding beacon in the plethora of commercial offerings and new and improved designs of hardware.

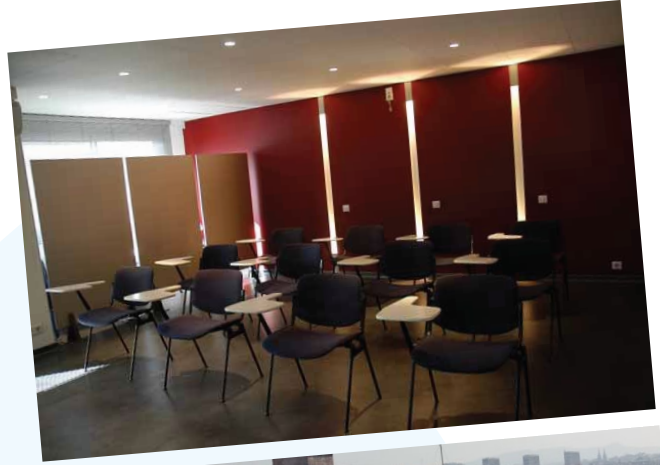
